Padua Academy gives young women a foundation for life – the yearning for excellence. We believe it is critical that our students *strive* and perform with high academic standards. Teachers, staff, parents, and students all contribute to our culture of achievement.

Student performance is impressive. This year, nearly \$2.8 million in scholarships was awarded to the Class of 2000, 98 percent of which pursued higher education. In recent years, Padua had a national Merit Finalist and several Commended Students. In addition, Padua has won awards for the past four years in the National History Day Competition. And, there are yet *many more* national and local honors.

Our faculty is also noteworthy. More than 60 percent have advanced degrees, and 8 percent hold doctorates. Teachers have received fellowships from the National Endowment for the Humanities and the National Science Foundation. Finally, Padua is a National School of Excellence, one of only 3 percent of such schools nationwide.

Padua is a culture of success and saturates young women with powerful values and habits. We nurture and reward their vision, courage and hard work. They're ready to discover the joys of excellence and add to our legacy.
